- (i) As per Govt instructions upper age limit is relaxable by 05 years for SC/ST, 03 years for OBC candidates with Creamy layer exclusion Certificate and 10 years to PH persons. No such relaxation would be available for SC/ST/OBC/PHP candidates applying against UR posts/vacancies. The upper age limit for EX-Serviceman is as per existing Government Orders i.e. 03 years after deduction of the military service rendered from the actual age as on the date.

(4) GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- O1. Candidates must carefully read all the conditions/instructions etc. given in the advertisement before they apply for any post so as to avoid any disappointment at later stage.
- 02. Application form in the prescribed format given in the Annexure "A" alongwith the relevant documents (mentioned below) should be submitted on A-4 size paper. The application form must be filled neatly in Capital Letters of English Language only. Application form received in any other format will be rejected.

- (i) **Copy** of Educational/Professional/Technical qualifications and Experience duly attested by Gazetted Officer.
- (ii) **Copy** of SC/ST/OBC(Non Creamy Layer)/PHP/Ex-Serviceman certificates issued by the Competent Authority as applicable in the prescribed proforma as per Government Instructions duly attested by Gazetted Officer.

- O5. Candidates must paste (not staple) a recent passport size coloured photograph (not more than 03 months old) duly attested by Gazetted Officer on the application form at the place provided for it and also enclose 03 (self attested in front and name of candidate & post applied for at the back of the photograph), more copies of the same photographs with the application form in a firm condition, in absence of which, the application form shall be summarily rejected.
- 06. The e-mail ID and Mobile No. entered in the Application form should remain valid / active until the recruitment process is completed. No change in the e-mail ID and Mobile No. will be allowed. The candidate himself/herself will be responsible for wrong or expired E-mail ID & Mobile No.
- 07. Mere submission of application form does not guarantee issue of Admit Card for the Written Test. Admit card will be issued only to those candidates who will be found FIT in the scrutiny of applications.
- 08. No traveling allowances will be paid to the candidates (Except "SC" & "ST" candidates) for appearing in the Written Examination/Skill Test. (ii) **SKILL TEST**: 50 Marks

Only those candidates who attain a minimum-qualifying standard of 40% in the written examination will be eligible to be called for skill test. The candidates qualifying as above should be called for skill test subject to the condition that the total number of candidates called for skill test does not exceed five times the declared vacancies.

SYLLABUS FOR EXAMINATION:

The questions will be of 10+2 Standard and would include both verbal and non-verbal type. The test may include questions to test the candidates understanding of English language and its correct usage.

(b) **GENERAL AWARENESS:**

(a) **GENERAL INTELLIGENCE**:

The questions will be of 10th Standard and would include both verbal and non-verbal type. The test may include questions on analogies, similarities and differences, space visualization, problem solving, analysis, judgement, decision making, visual memory, discrimination observation, relationship concept, figure classification, arithmetical number series, verbal and non-verbal series & mathematics of 10th standard. The test will also include questions designed to test the candidate's abilities to deal with abstract ideas and symbols and their relationship, mathematical computation and other analytical functions.

(b) **GENERAL AWARENESS:**

The questions will be of 10th Standard. Questions will be designed to test the ability of the candidate's general awareness of the environment around him and its application to society. Questions will also be designed to test knowledge of current events and of such matters of everyday observation and experience in their scientific aspects as may be expected of a 10th Standard educated person. The test will also include questions relating to India and its neighbouring countries especially pertaining to Sports, History, Culture, Geography, Economic scene, General Polity including Indian Constitution, and Scientific Research etc. These questions will be such that, they do not require a special study of any discipline.

This test will include questions on knowledge of Fire-Fighting, operational use of Fire Fighting Equipments, life savings drills, causes of fire etc.

Questions are also designed to test knowledge of current events and of such matters of everyday observation and experience in their specific aspect as may be expected of an educated person. The test will also include questions relating to India and its neighbouring countries especially pertaining to History, Culture, Geography, Economic Scene, General Policy and Scientific research.

NOTE 1: The questions will be of the level to commensurate with Educational Qualification prescribed for the post i.e. 12th Standard.

NOTE: Question paper will be set in English/Hindi/Major Regional Language of the state where the Factory is located except Part-II which will be set in English only.

SYLLABUS OF WRITTEN TEST:

(a) **GENERAL INTELLIGENCE**:

The questions will include both verbal and non-verbal type. The test may include questions on analogies, similarities, differences, space visualisation, visual memory, discrimination observation, relationship concept & 10th standard arithmetic.

(b) **GENERAL ENGLISH**:

The questions will include candidate's understanding of the Basics of English Language, its vocabulary, grammar, sentence structure, synonyms, antonyms and its correct usage, etc.

(c) GENERAL DRIVING AWARENESS:

The test will include common questions on General Knowledge, Traffic Rules, Knowledge about Motor Vehicles, their maintenance and repair.

(ii) **SKILL TEST**:

Skill Test on Driving shall be conducted for only those candidates who attain a minimum qualifying standard in the written examination. Number of candidates to be called for the Skill Test should be 1:5 i.e., five times the number of vacancies.

The Skill Test on driving will be same/similar to the test as are being conducted by the RTOs for giving Driving License.

The grading of candidates (selected in Written Test) will be done based on their assessed skill in driving, without taking into account the marks scored in the Written Test.

The candidates who qualify the main examination(s) will have to undergo a Skill Test for finding out their proficiency in handling PBX Board.

- * Only those candidates who secure in the Written (Main) Examination such minimum qualifying marks as may be fixed, will be eligible to be considered for appearing in the Skill Test.
- * This is a qualifying test only.

SYLLABUS:

(a) **GENERAL INTELLIGENCE**:

The questions will be of 10th Standard and would include questions of non-verbal type. The test may include questions on analogies, similarities and differences, space visualization, problem solving, analysis, judgement, decision making, visual memory, discrimination observation, relationship concepts, figure classification, arithmetical number series, and non-verbal series. The test will also include questions designed to test the candidate's abilities to deal with abstract ideas and symbols and their relationship, arithmetical computation and other analytical functions.

(b) **GENERAL AWARENESS:**

The questions will be of 10th Standard. Questions will be designed to test the ability of the candidate's general awareness of the environment around him and its application to society. Questions will also be designed to test knowledge of current events and of such matters of everyday observation and experience in their scientific aspects as may be expected of an 10th Standard educated person. The test will also include questions relating to India and its neighbouring countries especially pertaining to Sports, History, Culture, Geography, Economic scene, General Polity including Indian Constitution, and Scientific Research etc. These questions will be such that, they do not require a special study of any discipline.

(c) **ENGLISH LANGUAGE**:

The questions will be of 10th Standard. Candidate's understanding of the Basics of English language, its vocabulary, grammar, sentence structure, synonyms, antonyms and its correct usage, etc. and writing ability would be tested.

(d) **NUMERICAL APTITUDE:**

This paper will include questions on problems relating to Number Systems, Computation of Whole Numbers, Decimals and Fractions and relationship between Numbers, Fundamental arithmetical operations, Percentages, Ratio and Proportion, Averages, Interest, Profit and Loss, Discount, use of Tables and Graphs, Mensuration, Time and Distance, Ratio and Time, Time and Work etc. The question will be of 10th standard.

- (ii) The number of candidates to be called for the measurement of physical standards & screening test on the basis of merit in the written test shall be in the ratio of 1:10 to the number of vacancies. The physical test & screening test are only of qualifying nature.
 - (a) MEASUREMENT OF PHYSICAL STANDARDS (AS SPECIFIED IN THE SRO)
 - (b) **SCREENING TEST:** Running of 100 metres in 15 seconds.
- (iii) Final grading will be decided based on marks obtained in Written Test subject to qualifying in the measurement of physical standards test & Screening test.

(ii) **SKILL TEST:** 50 Marks

Only those candidates who attain a minimum-qualifying standard of 40% in the written examination will be eligible to be called for skill test. The candidates qualifying as above should be called for skill test subject to the condition that the total number of candidates called for skill test does not exceed five times the declared vacancies.

SYLLABUS FOR EXAMINATION:

(a) **GENERAL INTELLIGENCE**:

The questions will be of 10th standard and would include both verbal and non-verbal type. The test may include questions to test the candidates understanding of English language and its correct usage.

(b) **GENERAL AWARENESS**:

The questions will be designed to test the ability of the general awareness of the environment around the candidate and its application to soceity. Questions will be also be designed to test knowledge of current events and of such matters of everyday observation and experience in their scientific aspects as may be expected of an educated person of 10th standard. The test will also include questions relating to India and its neighbouring countries especially pertaining to History, Culture, Geography, Economic scene, General Policy and Scientific Research.

(c) TECHNICAL KNOWLEDGE:

The questions will be designed to test the knowledge and competence of the candidates' technical knowledge in the field of First-aid, Nursing, Ward-procedure etc.

(d) **SKILL TEST**:

The skill test should be designed to test the practical ability and skill of the candidates' in the following fields :

- 1. Bed making
- 2. Concepts of transportation of sick injured, carrying patients in trolley, stretcher wheel chair etc.
- 3. Sponging patients.
- 4. Practical knowledge of First-aid, nursing and ward procedures
- 5. Identification of simple Hospital equipments and their uses.
- 6. Dressing simple wounds.
